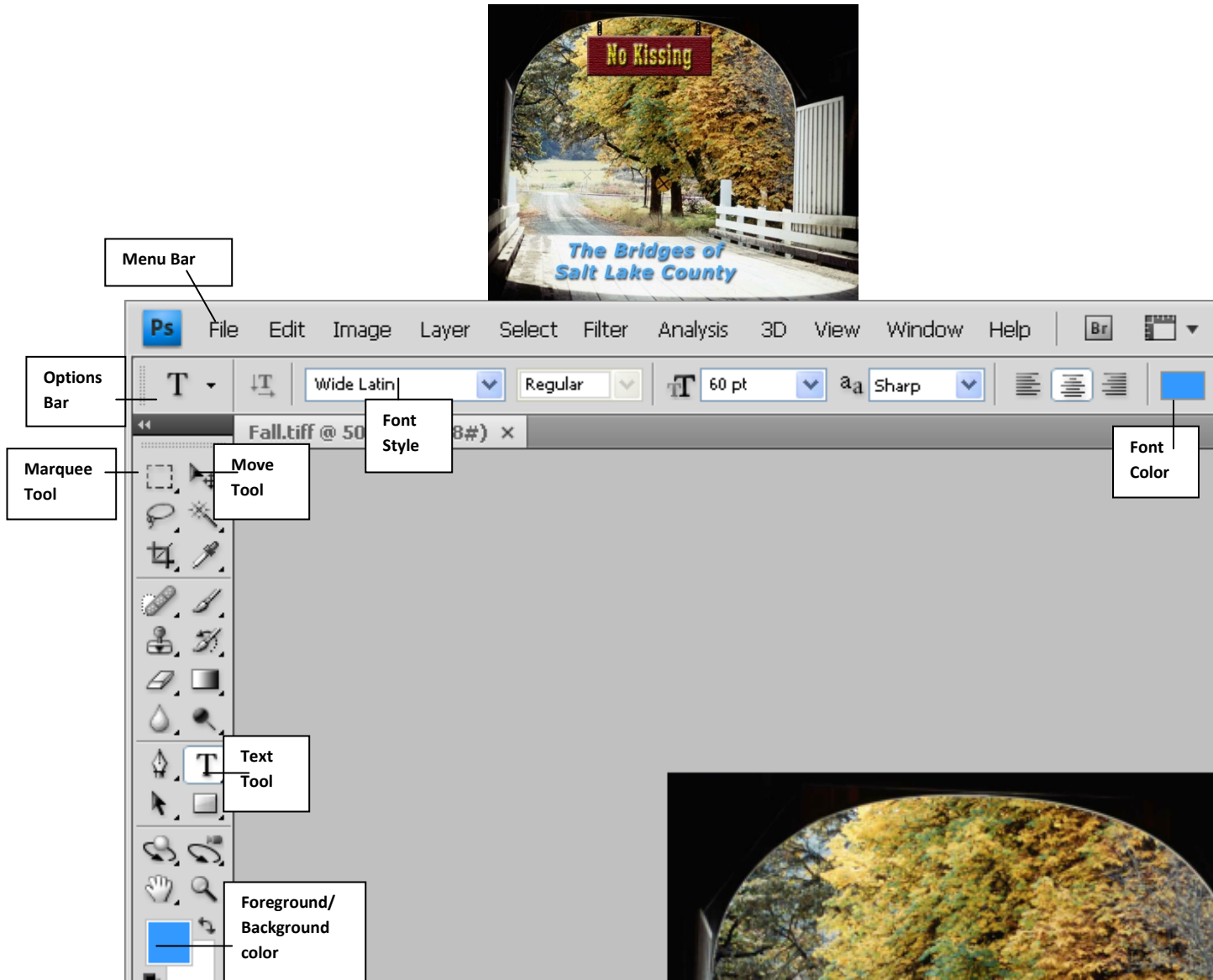


Photoshop Fun #1

(1) Open the file **Fall.tif**.

Shortcut: double click anywhere inside Photoshop to open a file! (does not work on MAC)



(2) Click on the *Text* tool to bring up the Options bar. Set the font to Verdana or a font of your choice, the color to R=72, G=170, B=249 or a color of your choice, and the font size to 36 or a font of your choice. Click the button for centered text, click on the image and type in **"The Bridges of"** <Enter> **"Utah County"** or text of your choice. (Make sure the Character palette is turned on by clicking Window on the Menu bar and selecting *Character*)

(3) Select the *Move* tool and move the text onto the sunlit floor of the bridge.

TIP: with the Move tool selected you can use the arrow keys to be more precise!

(4) Add a drop shadow by clicking on the Menu bar *Layer/Layer Style* "drop shadow" to the text. Adjust the settings to your liking.

Shortcut: double click next to the layer title to open Layer Style!

- (5) Click on the Menu bar *Layer/New/Layer* and name the new layer “sign”. On the toolbar, set the foreground color to R=102, G=9, B=19 or a color of your choice. With the *marquee* tool, make a rectangular box (ctrl-d will deselect the box, if you want to redo it). Select on the Menu bar *Edit/Fill* and *Foreground Color*. Give the sign some texture by selecting on the Menu bar *Filter/Texture/Texturizer/Grain* or choose one of your choice and click ok. (don't forget to try out the different settings available) Move the sign with the *Move* tool above the bridge entrance.
- (6) Give the sign some depth by selecting on the Menu bar *Layer/Layer Style/Bevel & Emboss* or choose one of your choice and click ok.
- (7) Create a chain to hang the sign using a text layer. Click on the text tool choose Verdana font or a font of your choice, 12 point font size or bigger, black or a color of your choice, and click the image and type a single “0”. Render the text layer to a graphic layer by using on the Menu bar *Layer/Rasterize/Layer*.
Shortcut: right click on layer and select Rasterize Layer!
- (8) Duplicate the layer four times and adjust the positions to look like a chain. To duplicate the layer, right-click your mouse and select duplicate layer. Select the copy layers and use the *Move* tool to adjust the positions to look like a chain.
- (9) Link all four zero layers by selecting on the Menu bar *Layer/Merge Down*. Repeat until all layers of the zero are merged down. (watch your layer panel and make sure you are only merging down the zero copies)
- (10) Duplicate the layer by right-clicking your mouse and selecting *duplicate layer* name it “second chain” and position the second chain onto the sign.
- (11) Type with the *Text* tool “No Kissing” or text of your choice and place the words on the sign using the color R=205, G=207, B=4 or a color of your liking. Select on the Menu bar *Edit/Transform/Scale* to modify the size (double-click to get out of “size” mode). Use the Emboss style for the text by selecting on the Menu bar *Layer/Layer Style* or a style of your choice. Distress the text with *Filter/Texture/Craquelure* or a choice of your liking.

(12) Choose File/Save As IC1_First_Last.psd. **Shortcut: Ctrl+Shift+s !**
