

## Photoshop Fun #IC8



- 1) Open **Glass\_windows.jpg**. (Hint: make a duplicate layer incase you need to go back to the original background)  
**Shortcut: double click anywhere inside Photoshop to open a file! (does not work on MAC)**
- 2) Color correct the image by clicking on the *Menu bar Image/Adjustments/Levels*.  
**Shortcut: CTRL+L – Auto Levels (CS4)**
- 3) Using the *Clone, Dodge, Burn, or Sponge* tools, copy/paste, adjustment layers, or any other Photoshop feature to remove the tree branches and leaves from on the right edge of the image.(Select/Deselect to start again)
- 4) Your goal is to make your final image look as if the branches and leaves were never there when viewed at 100%.
- 5) Save your image as **IC8a\_First\_Last.psd**.

## Photoshop Fun #IC9

- 1) Open **jacket\_change.ps**.



- 2) Color correct the image by selecting on the *Menu bar Image/Adjustment/Auto Levels*.  
**Shortcut: CTRL+L – Auto Levels (CS4)**
- 3) Change the color of the woman's jacket to a color of your choice. Select the jacket by using a selection tool of your choice. Remember, holding the *Shift* key down will let you select multiple areas. Also, try changing the Tolerance in the *Options* bar to 50 or more.
- 4) Click on *Layer/New Adjustment Layer/Hue/Saturation* and OK. Click on the *Colorize* box. Adjust the *Hue* slider to find the desired base color of your choice.
- 5) Using the same method described above, brighten the woman's teeth. Make sure the teeth look natural – just brighter. (Work with the image on your own for fun. Possibly, change the eye color.)
- 6) Save your image as **IC8b\_First\_Last.psd** and save to your I: drive and flash drive. Check off your screen with your instructor when both parts are completed.
